




## Crossroads

## Against Techno-Optimism!

- Internet **INFRASTRUCTURE** (as opposed to “web”/applications)
- **Layered** architecture, enabling: “network of networks”
  - end-to-end connectivity, “permission-less innovation”, decentralisation
- Tech/Science/Net has **NOT fulfilled its emancipatory promises**:
  - education, empowerment, equality, liberation, “democracy”, social justice ...

- "While the whole of society is being subsumed by algorithmically ordered relations and enrolled in machinic optimization, the history continues to show that liberation from the imposition of these power relations is a process brought about by collective organizing, mutual care and #solidarity .."
- Given the urgent need to provide some kind of balance as the "algorithmic empire" becomes a multiplier of epistemic injustices, administrative violence and algorithmic states of exception, the Algorithmic Sabotage Research Group (ASRG) proposes "algorithmic sabotage" as a form of constituent counter-power and the basis for an alternative radical political tactic that resists necropolitical authoritarianism and militantly refuses reductive optimisations and statistical segregation through a perspective of care and mutuality, while pushing for structural alternatives ."




