







Humanity is going to require a substantially new way of thinking in order to survive. (Albert Einstein)


- The world is falling apart

- We can pass on our knowledge to new generations












Life on Earth Genus Home



Old story

- The world was made for Man, and Man was made to conquer and rule the world.

- Human nature is flawed; Man is born bad, sinful, aggressive & selfish

New stories

- Man belongs to the world
- Man is part of the natural world, is dependent on it for survival.
- Men is connected to the world, and to all living beings.
- Laws of Life do apply to Men
- Human nature is based on connection and cooperation and altruism and empathy

New stories can come from Great Remembering & Tribal pre-history

- Before Great Forgetting (4000 BC), "humans" lived in tribes, of which some practiced agriculture, and some not
- For 240.000 years, Homo Sapiens lived in tribes and some still do!!
 - Mosuo, Himba, Maasai, Yanomami, Piranha, Bushman...
- Tribal ways can show us "the new ways"

The Tribal Laws vs Civilization Laws

- Food is free
- The law of limited competition: you may compete but you may not wage war on your competitors.
- Nothing in nature takes more then it needs.
- Ecology: More food, more population
- You must work for food, food is under lock&key
- Totalitarian agriculture: all the food in the world belongs to us
- More land, more food production, more population growth.
- Laws of ecology do not apply to "us"

Life-affirming Tribal Laws

- Tribal Laws work well for all concerned
- Tribal Laws promote biological diversity within the community of Life.
- Tribal Laws have protected us from extinction for three million years

Hackers story

- Based on commons and sharing, openness & freedom
- Egalitarian, volunteering, meritrocratic. decentralized
- Curious, questioning, open minded
- Searching for alternatives

- NOT proprietary
- NOT hierarchical / power based
- ♦ NOT dogmatic, NOT believing in "one right way"
- NOT based on consumerism

Why hackers?

- Positive:
- we already are tribal
- we are already against mainstream culture
- we are already considered a danger to the existing society
- It is my tribe

- Negative:
- we believe in / depend on industry, technology, science, progress...
- we use lots of energy for HW & networking
- we are cause of lots of pollution & exploitation

Hackers as a model of a new tribe • Tribes share food

- s / tribe / hackerspace
- Tribe is a form of organisation that works equally well for all members
- Tribal wealth is the energy that tribal members give each other in order to keep the tribe going
- s / food / information • When food is scarce,
- share it
- Food wants to be free
- Freedom of food
- Sharing is caring.

Life-affirming aspects of hackers ethics

- Embracing play
- Fostering close relationships
- Focusing on the intrinsic values, rather then on the external markers of power, prestige or material wealth
- Serving a purpose greater then ourselves
