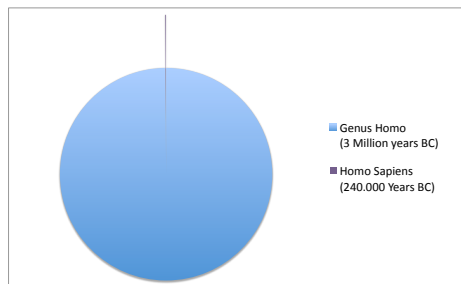

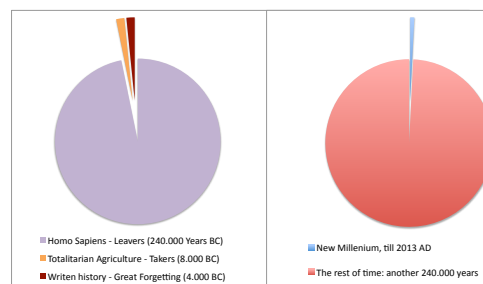
The Community of Life obeys the Laws of Life for 4 Billion years

Homo Sapiens lived without Totalitarian Agriculture till ~10.013 years ago...

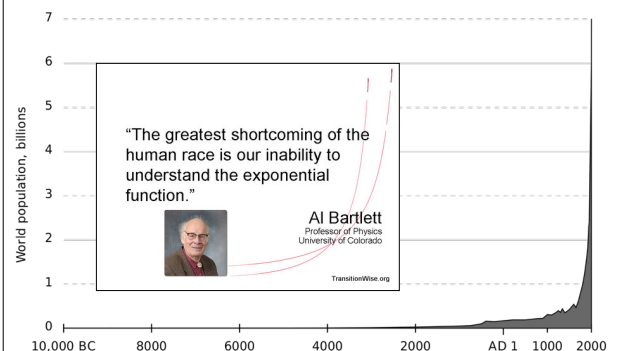


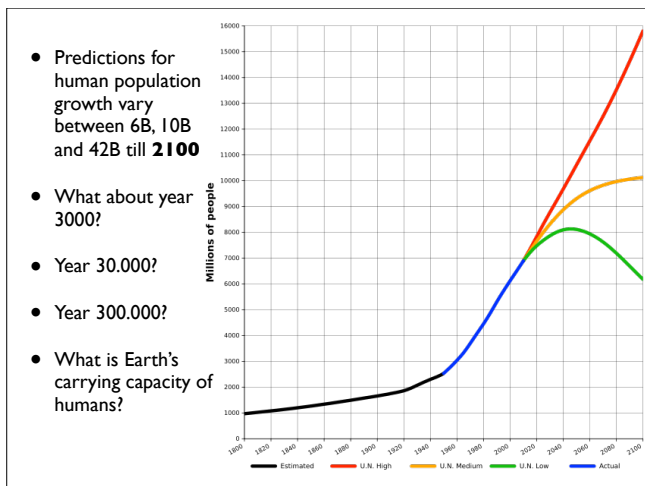
What about next 240.000 years?

New stories can come from Great Remembering & Tribal pre-history

Hackers story

- Based on commons and sharing, openness & freedom
- Egalitarian, volunteering, meritocratic, decentralized
- Curious, questioning, open minded
- Searching for alternatives
- ✦ NOT proprietary
- ✦ NOT hierarchical / power based
- ✦ NOT dogmatic, NOT believing in "one right way"
- ✦ NOT based on consumerism

Why hackers?

- Positive:
 - we already are tribal
 - we are already against mainstream culture
 - we are already considered a danger to the existing society
 - It is my tribe
- Negative:
 - we believe in / depend on industry, technology, science, progress...
 - we use lots of energy for HW & networking
 - we are cause of lots of pollution & exploitation

Hackers as a model of a new tribe

- s / tribe / hackerspace
- Tribes share food
- Tribe is a form of organisation that works equally well for all members
- s / food / information
- When food is scarce, share it
- Tribal wealth is the energy that tribal members give each other in order to keep the tribe going
- Food wants to be free
- Freedom of food
- Sharing is caring.

Life-affirming aspects of hackers ethics

- Embracing play
- "tend to play with any rule or system"
- Fostering close relationships
- Welcoming and inclusive
- Focusing on the intrinsic values, rather than on the external markers of power, prestige or material wealth
- Supporting diversity
- Using peer-created conflict resolution processes
- Serving a purpose greater than ourselves
- Hackercamps (and hackerspaces)

- Love is all we have left



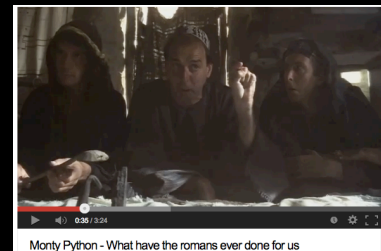
What to do?
