




IPv6 Addresses Distribution








Internet Governance & Global Warming Timeline



Painfully Slow... Why?

- focused on growth
- efficiency myth (<u>Jevons paradox</u>)
- aligned with dominant power structures

Beliefs:

- "tech is neutral"
- "we are the good guys" bias
- tech optimism

Individualism

Individuals and consumers are ultimately responsible for taking actions to address climate change.

Whataboutism

Our carbon footprint is trivial compared to [...]. Therefore it makes no sense for us to take action, at least until [...] does so.

The 'free rider' excuse

Reducing emissions is going to weaken us. Others have no real intention of reducing theirs and will take advantage of that.

Change is impossible

Any measure to reduce emissions effectively would run against current ways of life or human nature and is thus impossible to implement in a democratic society.

Doomism

Any mitigation actions we take are too little, too late. Catastrophic climate change is already locked-in. We should adapt, or accept our fate in the hands of God or nature. Someone else should take actions first: redirect responsibility

It's not possible to mitigate climate change: surrender Discourses of climate delay

Disruptive change is not necessary: push nontransformative solutions

Change will be disruptive: emphasize the downsides

Policy perfectionism

We should seek only perfectly-crafted solutions that are supported by all affected parties; otherwise we will waste limited opportunities for adoption.

Appeal to well-being

Fossil fuels are required for development. Abandoning them will condemn the global poor to hardship and their right to modern livelihoods.

Appeal to social justice

Climate actions will generate large costs. Vulnerable members of our society will be burdened; hard-working people cannot enjoy their holidays.

Technological optimism

We should focus our efforts on current and future technologies, which will unlock great possibilities for addressing climate change.

All talk, little action

We are world leaders in addressing climate change. We have approved an ambitious target and have declared a climate emergency.


Fossil fuel solutionism


The Internet of Empathy

- Positive freedom of connectivity, interaction and involvement
 - Instead of libertarian "freedom" as independence and self reliance
- This freedom comes together with greater responsibility
- "the intrinsic value of a network does not lie in the sovereignty and independence of its nodes, but in their connectedness,"
- "Empathy is willingness to engage with the Other, and willingness to enrich network with our contributions"

NVC = empathy & honesty

Gift Economics is based in what Marshall Rosenberg called "natural giving" – when human beings give and receive freely out of our intrinsic desire to contribute to one another.



Quote by Marshal Rosenberg

For about 10.000 yers over most of our planet people have been operating according to, what I call, domination structures, structures in which some people claim to be superiors and have the right to control others because they know what's best.

Some of these people called themselves kings, tzars... It's very important for their structures to (be able to) sustain themselves, for people to be educated to be obedient to them.

So how do you educate people to be submissive and obedient?

You need to teach them a language in which they get disconnected from their own power and look outward to authority to guide how are they meant to live.

To do this requires a language that is static, that describes what people *are*, whether they are "good" or "bad", right or wrong, normal or abnormal...

So, to maintain domination structures, a core component is to educate people with such static language, that uses the verb "to be" in ways that judges people: their behavior, their appearance, their intelligence;

and in addition to this language that i call "a language of domination", it's also important to teach people **retributive justice**: retributive justice basically implies that if you are judged as bad by the authorities, you deserve to suffer for it, to receive punishment and if you are positively judged by authorities as good, then you deserve to be rewarded.

This is at the heart of violence on our planet.
